BEGAN TO STALL
Khrushchev got the Soviet missiles out of Cuba fast, but began to stall on withdrawing 5000 jet bombers. He finally agreed to pull that part of his bargain also and Kennedy then ended the U.S. naval blockade of Cuba.

But the Soviet pledge of international inspection of the dismantled Soviet bases in Cuba is still unfulfilled. International safeguards against the secret re-introduction of Soviet nuclear weapons still are lacking.

The Cuban crisis, therefore, is far from over. It has developed the loose ends, tangled and untidy, so characteristic of more ordinary east-west differences. It may drag on for months with diminishing zeal and increasing irritation.
