

CONTRACT BRIDGE

The bidding:

Opening lead—king of spades. Many bridge textbooks carry a chapter on mathematics devoted to the probabilities connected with suit breaks, when to finesse, when to bid a game or slam, and kindred subjects. Such statistics should not be followed blindly. Whenever there are contrary indications, or special reasons to do so, the practical bridge player abandons the mathematical formulae.

One of the specific situations treated in some texts is the question of whether or not it is proper to finesse when there is a combined holding in both hands of ten cards in a suit, with the defenders having K-x-x. This was exactly South's problem in today's hand.

The text says, and correctly, that the percentage play is to finesse rather than play to drop the singleton king behind the ace. What this means is that if you were to experiment thousands of times with this combination the finesse would succeed more often than the play to drop.

Our South today was fully familiar with the percentage play. When West opened the king of spades and shifted at trick played dummy's king, which held the trick. Without bothering to get to his hand South next played the ace of hearts, catching East's lone king. This fine maneuver not only made the contract but produced two overtricks.

South had an excellent reason for refusing the trump finesse. The bidding had revealed that West could not have the king of hearts. West had passed originally and, on the first two plays, marked himself with the ace-king of spades and the ace of clubs. It was not reasonable to assume he might also have the king of hearts, in view of his previous pass.

It would therefore have been poor policy to attempt a finesse that was sure to fail. Once the king is granted to East, the only hope that remains is that it is unguarded. The possibility is by no means remote, considering there are only three hearts out. Luckily, this proves to be the case.

"How am I lucky?" demanded Lightfoot.


"To be able to eat food that can be found all the time," replied Buster.






