PARIS, Sept. 13 (CP Hava)—
Canada's entry into the war was
consecrated at the tomb of the
Unknown Soldier here today in a
simple and moving ceremony.

Discovery Is
New Field in
Cancer Study
ATLANTIC CITY, N.J., Sept. 13
(AP)—The first scientific proof
that there is a personal electric field
around a living body, was announce-
ed to the third international cancer
congress here today.

experiment by which the great
English scientist, Michael Faraday,
discovered the electric current. The
latter placed a coil of wire in a
magnetic field. When he moved the
wire, electricity flowed in the coil.

These living fields of electricity
have north and south poles, like
magnets. It is virtually certain that
they exist the same in human beings
as in animals.

Dr. Burr said it may be possible
that these electrical fields determine
"to a very real sense the structural
character of the organism. This im-
plies that in normal growth and de-
velopment the field controls and re-
gulates the chemical processes in-
volved in the formation of struc-
tural units.
