Was Do Or Die, Robinson Says

NEW YORK, Sept. 12 — (AP) — Sugar Ray Robinson, who regained his middleweight title from Randolph Turpin with a spectacular 10th-round technical knockout tonight, said in a quiet, tired voice when it was all over:

"After my eye got cut, it was do or die. I didn't want to take any chances with the referee stopping the fight."

Reporters pressed the sleek Robinson to find out how Turpin managed to bring such a stream of blood from the torn eyebrow.

"I don't know how he did it. No, I don't know if he butted me or hit me."

Ted Waltham of the British Boxing Commission, a large and dignified man, edged his way through the shouting, perspiring circle that surrounded Robinson.

Waltham extended his hand in congratulations.

"Will I be welcome back in England," asked Robinson with an anxious grin.

"You're always welcome," said Waltham.

Empire Team Scores

Maj. Cyril H. Frisby, tall and stately, holder of the Victoria Cross and London stock broker, hooked no. 1, weighing about 579 pounds, to make the British Empire team first to break into the scoring. Before he had hoisted his fish Knud Kyvsgaard of Copenhagen, put the Scandanavian team in the lead by hooking a 805-pounder which he landed after a tough fight.

Then Joaquin Edwards of Santiago, scored for the defending Chilean team with a 660-pounder.

The scoring is based on poundage, biggest fish caught and largest number.

The score at the end of the first day was Scandanavia 1,071, 2/3, Chile 726 2/3 and British Empire 663 2/3.

The United States and Cuban teams didn't score and they both had bad luck. Two Cuban team members battled tuna for 45 and 11 minutes respectively and their leaders broke.

ery time you raise your head a bit. These examples of 'head raising' are slight, yet the variance of pattern centers is enough to prove that things are not always as they seem when the shooter's head is even slightly raised.

"If the shooter will develop the habit of making sure that the gun butt is high enough on his shoulder so that his cheek can be placed against the stock and the head kept in a fairly erect position, he will find that the alignment of the gun properly will become pretty much a matter of instinct. Raising the head or trying to set the shoulder away from the gun butt not only spoils good shooting chances but also aggravates re-

coil sensation.

The shooter who holds his gun properly seldom feels it 'kick'. Bulky clothing is often the unsuspected cause of shooting over the target. It is a handicap to the in-

stant placing of the gun butt on the shoulder, and if the gun butt is low the charge of shot is generally high.

"Raising the head, with its consequence of shooting too high, has resulted in more crippled and lost game than, perhaps, any other shooting fault. Our most frequent error, it is the easiest to correct... if we will only remember to KEEP THAT HEAD DOWN."
