NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - The New York stock market ran its recovery drive through the second straight session Thursday. Trading was the heaviest of the week. Volume climbed to 257,000 shares from 7,700,000 Wednesday.
The Dow Jones industrial average advanced 4.24 to 881.87, once more emerging above the significant 800 level.
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced 2.0 to 236.7, of 1,444 issues traded, 745 rose and 427 fell. New highs for the year totalled 20 and new lows 17.
Ten of the 15 most active stocks rose and five fell. Wilson and Co. was the most active stock, up 6 1/2 at 61 1/2 on 312,700 shares. The stock spurred on news that Ling-Temco-Vought had offered \$25 a share for 750,000 shares of the stock.
Among Canadian stocks, Alcan rose 1/2. Distillers Securities 1/2, Dome Mines 1/2, Graydon Mining 1/2, International Nickel 1/2 and Manney Ferguson 1/2.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - Prices rallied slightly Thursday towards the final bell on the Montreal Stock Exchange but the rise gave advances only a slight edge over declines.
Trading was dull and uneven for most of the session.
The slight rise moved the composite index up 0.21 to 148.59.
The volume was moderate with a combined industrial total of 123,500 and mines and oils 674,800 compared with 158,000 and 623,000 Wednesday.
On the industrial list, Alcan advanced 1/2 to 31 1/2 and Simpson 1/2 to 24 1/2. Dominion Glass fell 1/2 to a new low of 12 while Du Pont and Imperial Tobacco each dropped 1/2 to 34 1/2 and 12 1/2 respectively.

Interprovincial Pipe Line added 1/2 to 8 1/2 and B.C. Telephone 1/2 to 61. Brinco was off five cents at \$3.85 and Quebec Telephone 1/2 to 18 1/2.
