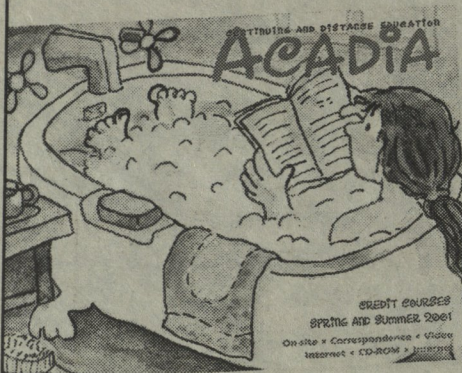

## School of Business CHANGES TO CURRICULUM

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of changes to the curriculum which take effect at the end of the current academic year (May 1/2001). Please review the changes listed below carefully, as these changes may impact on your course selections and timings.

1. **Bus. 250 - Management Science (6 credit hours)** is replaced by **Bus. 251 - Management Science I (3 credit hours)** and **Bus. 252 - Management Science II (3 credit hours)**. Bus. 251 and 252 will be offered in alternating semesters.
2. **Bus. 377 (Organizational Behaviour)** - is renumbered as **Bus. 271**, and becomes a required course in the second year of the BBA. NB: Those students entering third year of the BBA, or first year of the BBTH, who would be registering for Bus. 377 will now register for Bus. 271. In order to cope with anticipated demand, we will also be offering Bus. 271 this summer - check the schedule!!
3. **Bus. 390 - Integrated Functional Management (6 credit hours)** is replaced by **Bus. 332 - Integrated Cases in Corporate Finance (3 credit hours)** and **Bus. 342 - Integrated Cases in Marketing (3 credit hours)**. To meet your individual scheduling requirements, note that Bus. 332, Bus. 342, and Bus. 371 - Entrepreneurship may be taken in third or fourth year of the BBA (first or second year of the BBTH).
4. A new business elective, **Bus. 492 - Integrated Functional Management (3 credit hours)** will be offered beginning in 2002/03.
5. The number of Management Context courses required to complete the BBA is reduced from three to two.
6. Students are now eligible to apply to the Cooperative Education program at the end of first year of the BBA (or upon entry to the BBTH). **IN ORDER TO BE ABLE TO GRADUATE IN FOUR YEARS WITH CO-OP, STUDENTS SHOULD CONSIDER TAKING COURSES DURING THE SUMMER SESSIONS.** A minimum 70% median grade is required for admission. Students are also eligible to apply to the Cooperative Education program at a later time.
