

# Stevenson Urges Help In Poland's Bid For Freedom

NEW YORK (AP) — Adlai E. Stevenson Tuesday night called for help for Poland's bid for freedom from Russian control and again urged the United States to take the lead in "curbing" this "ghostly killer," the H bomb.

The Democratic presidential nominee started the final two weeks of his campaign with an appearance in Madison Square Garden. It was the first speech in a nonstop drive aimed chiefly at swinging big city votes. It was broadcast and televised.

Stevenson related that he had suggested "long before this campaign that we take the lead in curbing this ghostly killer," the hydrogen bomb. He termed it a matter of moral responsibility as well as national security.

He said the Democrats "have broken through the blanket of warm, wet fog with which the administration had planned to smother the country" and have turned the campaign into a debate on policies.

**CAN BREAK ARMS RACE**

And he said the United States should be prepared to join other nations in offering economic aid to Poland.

Stevenson returned to his duel with President Eisenhower on the Democratic candidate's proposal that agreements be sought to ban further H. bomb tests.

"Here is one place where we can break out of the deadly vise of the arms race," he said.

"I think we must make this effort in the name of humanity. I don't think President Eisenhower should irritably close the door to discussion or agreement on a matter of such vast importance to mankind."

Stevenson reiterated his support of President Eisenhower's view that Soviet Premier Bulganin's latest offer to discuss the subject was interference in the U.S. political campaign, but he added:

"Yet I regret that Mr. Eisenhower has once more enabled the Russians to present themselves as apostles of peace. I think the anxious world awaits positive action in this field."

**RETAIN DEFENCES**

"If the Russian offer is a fake let us call their bluff. If it is genuine, so much the better."

Stevenson said, however, that U.S. national defence should be "second to none" until the other side agrees to enforceable safeguards.

Taking up his plea for aid to Poland's move to get out of Russian domination, the nominee stated:

"We must help if we can, and if Soviet pressure continues and the Polish government wishes it, I believe we should assist in bringing the matter before the United Nations."

## More Babies Were Born In September

OTTAWA (CP) — More Canadian babies were born in September than in the corresponding month last year, the bureau of statistics said Tuesday.

Births in the month rose eight per cent to 37,825 from 35,35 in 1955, but registrations for the January-September period remained virtually unchanged at 334,826, compared with 333,400.

Deaths declined to 9,751 from 9,765 in the month but rose to 98,589 from 95,895 in the nine-month period. Marriages dropped 10 per cent in the month to 14,411 from 15,982 but rose four per cent to 93,709 from 89,850 in the nine months.

## Canadian-born Pilot Is Missing

LONDO (CP) — A Canadian-born pilot has been missing for three weeks on a flight from Britain to Iraq, it was learned Tuesday.

Bill Brailsford, 27-year-old freelance ferry pilot from Neepawa and Dauphin, Man., disappeared Oct. 3 on a flight from Paris to Marseille, France, while ferrying a new single-engine Auster aircraft to the Iraq Airplane Society of Baghdad.
