WINNIPEG (CP)—Good commercial demand in barley high-lighted trading as most grains closed higher Tuesday on the Winnipeg grain exchange. The active barley dealings were due to export, shippers and U. S. demand.

Overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat included: United Kingdom 800,000 bushels; Switzerland 380,000; Japan 350,000; India 350,000; Belgium 165,000; Ecuador 165,000; Colombia 40,000; and small parcel shipments to Rhodesia and Venezuela.

Lakehead prices for the top grades of class two, IWA and domestic wheat were unchanged from Monday except for the No. 1 durum of IWA and domestic which regained the one-eighth cent lost Monday.
