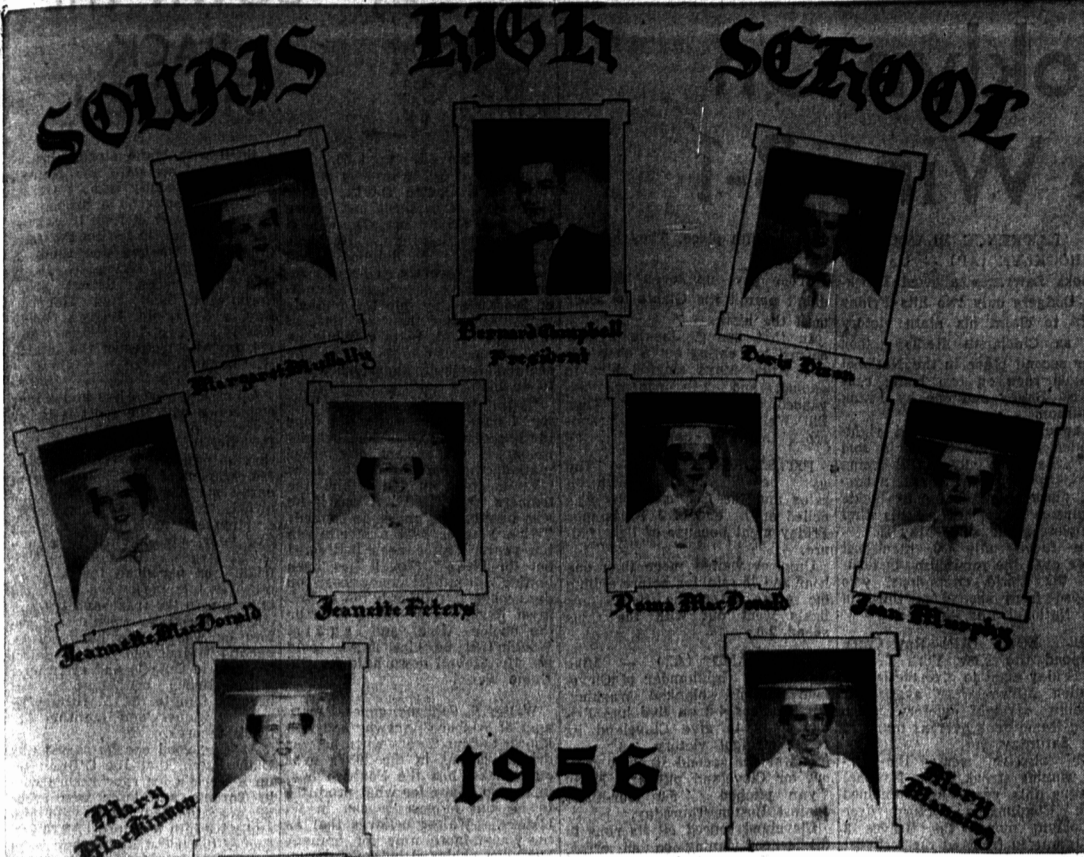

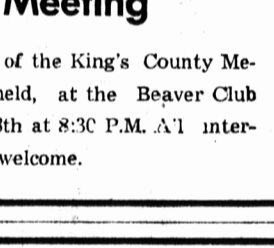
PERSONALS
