Marilyn Bowering, that is, not Marilyn Monroe. Bowering is a poet and fiction writer from Victoria, B.C., who will read from her new book of poems, Autobiography, and her latest fiction at Confederation Centre Library on Thursday, February 5, at 8:00 p.m.

Bowering did publish a book of poems about her famous namesake, Anyone Can See I Love You: The Marilyn Monroe Poems. Since 1973 she has published over a dozen books of poetry and fiction. Memorable titles include Giving Back Diamonds, To All Appearances a Lady, The Liberation of Newfoundland, and The Killing Room. She was short-listed in 1984 for the Governor General's Award for Poetry, and again in 1997 for Autobiography. Bowering's writing is lively, gutsy, immediate, and entertaining.

Bowering's performance is part of the "Winter's Tales VI" reading series sponsored by the UPEI English Department, with the generous support of The Canada Council of the Arts and the gracious cooperation of Confederation Centre Library. Admission is free. For further information phone 566-0389.
