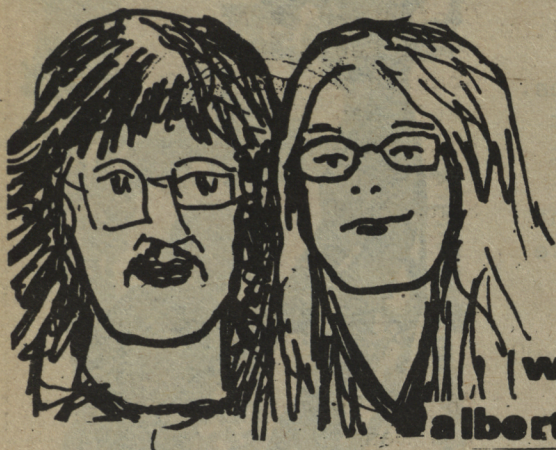

## Ponderosa

### Hoss's Trough

We have decided to open the new year with a review of a new establishment, the Ponderosa Steak House on University Avenue. The newest member of a rapidly growing Canadian chain it specializes in quick services and low priced steaks.

We found the place to be spotlessly clean, and decorated in a slightly "Western" Style, with guns and cattle horns mounted on the walls,

shoot-em-out cowboy murals, and homey signs, such as "Fill yore canteen here, pardner" over the drinking fountain.

The service was cafeteria style and very efficient. You pick one of the six meals, take a marker bearing the appropriate number, and put it together as you move along. We noted a certain salesmanship in this aspect as various optionals were pressed upon



us have some mushroom sauce a roll sour cream coffee etc, with no mention of the fact that they were optionals. We also noted that pats of butter cost three cents each, a novel way to cut down on costs. Possibly as inflation continues we will be charged for wear and tear on the cutlery.

We ordered the number-two dinner, which is always a special Tuesday nights for \$1.39. It consists of a six-ounce rib steak, baked potato, and salad. The food was served quickly and tasted extremely good. Prices, we saw, ranged from \$1.29 for the chopped

steak dinner to \$3.14 for the sirloin steak, unusually low prices for this type of meal.

Since the Ponderosa is primarily a family type establishment, its hours are 11-9 on weekdays and 11-11 on Saturdays. As such we consider it most appropriate for daytime meals or meals before a movie or other casual occasions.

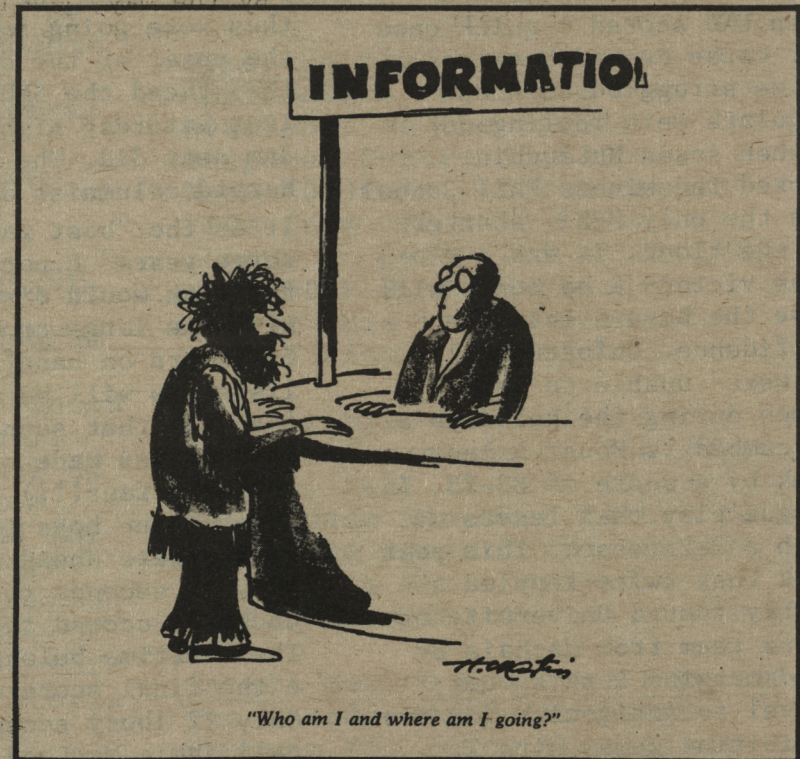

With its quick service, low prices, and good food, we recommend it highly as an informal place to eat and suggest you go there soon to try it out.
