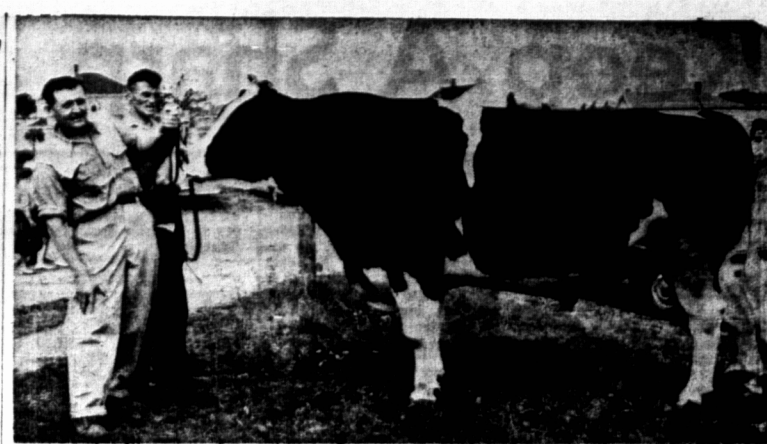

Dosco Buyer Had Ups And Downs

Eleven years ago A. V. Roe Canada Ltd., the big industrial organization which proposes to acquire control of Dominion Steel and Coal Corporation Ltd.—was frequently described as "Dobson's folly."
Dobson is Sir Roy Dobson, a director of the Hawker Siddeley Group Ltd. of Britain—world's largest aviation manufacturing group—and chairman of A. V. Roe Canada.
In mid-1945 with the war in Europe over—Sir Roy reached the basis of an agreement with the federal government under which Hawker Siddeley would take over the government-owned Victory Aircraft at Malton, near Toronto.
The idea was that current contracts for Lancaster and Lincoln aircraft would serve to get it going.
In August, however, the war with Japan ended and, with widespread cancellation of airplane contracts, the proposal looked like a dead issue.
Not to Sir Roy, however. As noted by Scott Young in a company history, he declared by transatlantic telephone: "I made a deal and I'm going to stick with it, and what the hell's all the talk about."

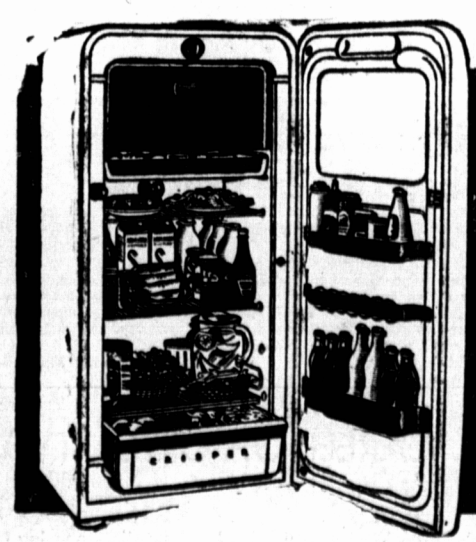

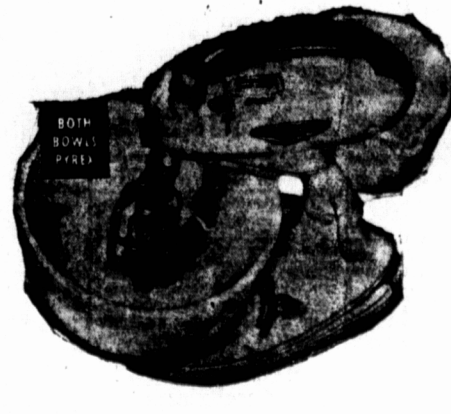
