MONTREAL (CP)—The United States dollar closed at a discount of 1 1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, Tuesday, down 1/32. It took 98 15-32 cents Canadian to buy 1 American. Pound sterling \$2.77 9-16, down 3-16.

## Grains

WINNIPEG (CP)—A sharp break in flax prices highlighted dealings on the Winnipeg grain exchange Tuesday. Losses as much as 15 cents—the maximum decline permitted—were recorded at one stage. The May contract wound up 14 1/2 cents lower.

The declines were prompted by reports that the United States government surplus flax stocks were being offered on the world markets at prices sharply below current quotations.

Export loadings of Canadian wheat overnight included: United Kingdom 455,000 bushels; Brazil 600,000; Germany 1,065,000; and Norway 190,000.

Lakhead prices for the top grades of class two, IVA and domestic wheat were unchanged from Monday.
