(JDM, BB, RP, RC); **Red-breasted Merganser** - 1 ♂ at Bothwell on Feb. 13 (FRC); **Northern Goshawk** - 1 at Cardigan dump on Jan. 22 (GS), 1 at Glen Rd on Feb. 9 (AM); **Broad-winged Hawk** - dark phase observed for 20 minutes at China Point and Earnscliffe on Jan. 19 (JDM, BB, EM); **Rough-legged Hawk** - 2 dark phase at New London in December (LDo), 1 at Cambridge on Jan. 15 (FRC), 5 seen between Meadowbank & Augustine Cove on Jan. 16 (DC, GP), 2 at Ross Corner on Jan. 19 (GMa), 1 at Glenfinnon on Feb. 23 (B&RH); **Bald Eagle** - 2 immature and 3 adult from early fall to Feb. in Cherry Valley area (JH); **Northern Harrier** - 1 ♂ at China Point on Jan. 19 (JDM, BB), 1 ♀ at Fullerton's Marsh on Jan. 24 (JDM); **Osprey** - 1 at Bonshaw during Christmas break and Jan. 12 (DWa); **Gyr Falcon** - 1 seen at Argyll Shore on Jan. 20 (LY), 1 at Bear River on Jan. (GM); **Hawk spp** - many this winter in Cherry Valley area (JH); **Gray Partridge** - 12 at Wheatley River in early Dec. (LDo), 11 at Sea View in early Jan. (N&SB), 7 at Newton on Jan. 9 (FRC), 12 at Hunter River feeder in mid Jan. (JS), 12 seen in a rosette at 1230 in Vernon Bridge on Jan. 18 (JDM, BB, EM), 6 at Stratford on Jan. 22 (ASm), 5 at Summerville on Feb. 5 (FRC), 12 at Beech Grove on Feb. 19 (JDM); **Ruddy Turnstone** - 1 at Rice Point the week of Dec. 7 (reported to DW); **Plover** - one, a probable Black-bellied Plover was seen on the ice near the edge of open water on the Cardigan River on Jan. 4 (GS); **Mourning Dove** - up to 50 at Summerside feeder and water station until Dec. 31 (WB), 10 to 25 at Kensington feeder Jan-Feb (HC), 2 at Monticello feeder in Jan. (GM), 11 at Cardigan on Feb. 5 (BSh); **Great Horned Owl** - 1 in Stratford in Feb. being mobbed by approx. 100 crows (WP); **Snowy Owl** - 1 at Lot 16 in mid-Dec. (Mma), 1 at Cavendish on Jan. 8 (RD), 1 at Fort Augustus on Feb. 16 (B&RH); **Short-eared Owl** - 1 at China Point on Jan. 10 (JH), 1 at Cherry Valley on Feb. 1 (JH); **Boreal Owl** - 1 at Cousin's Shore on Oct. 19 (NB); **Northern Flicker** - 1 seen in late fall at Summerside water station near feeder (WB); **Red-bellied Woodpecker** - ♂ still present at Parkdale feeder on Jan. 12 (JC); **Pileated Woodpecker** - 1 at Point Prim on Dec. 10 (reported to DW); **Gray Jay** - 2 at Village Green on Feb. 1 (JH); **Common Raven** - 5 at Hunter River in mid-Jan. (JS), 50 ravens in the Hartsville area near Route 13 with 40 of these clustered in and around a manure pile with chicken feathers in it (JDM); **Northern Mockingbird** - 1 in Charlottetown on Dec. 13 (JHo); **American Robin** - 1 on Jan. 24 at Cardigan (GS), 1 at Pleasant Grove on Jan. 20 (MR), 1 at Stratford feeder on Feb. 14 (WP); **Bohemian Waxwing & Cedar Waxwing** - very few reports and a low berry crop this winter; **Yellow-rumped Warbler** - reported at PEI National Park on Dec. 22 (DO); **Pine Warbler** - 1 at New Dominion on Dec. 24 (PC); **Common Grackle** - a long straggling line travelling E-SE over Sherwood on Oct. 20 (DW); **Evening Grosbeak** - most feeders report very few this winter; **American Goldfinch** - sightings down this winter in general, WB reported that about Sep. 24 a flock of 20+ suddenly left his and 2 other nearby feeders and 6 reappeared on Dec. 15 only to leave again, 8 at Pleasant Grove feeder in Jan. (MR), 25 at Cardigan on Feb. 5 (BSh); **American Tree Sparrow** - 1 at Pleasant Grove feeder in Jan. (MR), 7 or 9 at Monticello feeder in Jan. (GM), 7 at Donagh feeder on Feb. 22 (JDM); **Lapland Longspur** - 1 at feeder in Pleasant Grove on Jan. (MR); **Snow Bunting** - 25 at Fortune Cove, 8 at Cascumpec, 5 at Skinner's Pond, 30 at Nail Pond, and 40 at Harper on Jan. 9 (FRC).

Older sightings: Dave Biggar noted that a Cattle Egret was present at the semi-natural rearing area immediately after the fish kill last summer. He also noted that wild turkeys were being released in the West Prince area. HC reported 25 to 41 Mourning Dove at his Kensington Feeder in winter of 1995-96. GM reported a Gyr Falcon at Monticello 2 years ago. T&MJ reported a Northern Mockingbird visit their Frenchfort property and providing entertainment by mimicking numerous other birds from July 5 to 13th and also on July 19th. White-crowned Sparrow on Oct. 5 (DB)
