BERNADINE HALL BURSARY AWARD

COMMONWEALTH SCHOLARSHIPS

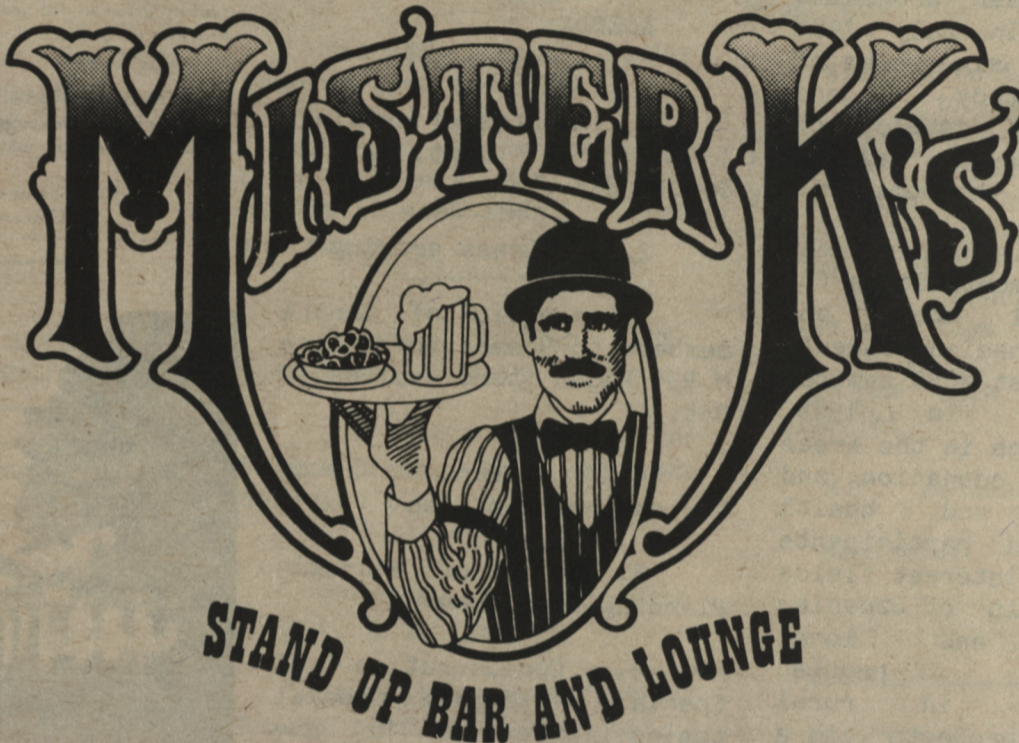
For students graduating in May of '84: Those who wish to pursue postgraduate study in a foreign country for the academic year '84-85 should be aware that the deadline for most of the Commonwealth countries is October 31st, 1983. The deadline for Australia and New Zealand is December 31st, 1983. These awards are available to men and women who are Canadian citizens to pursue postgraduate study. The value of the award covers
