New England Mackerel.

THE SMALLEST CATCH FOR THE LAST SEVENTY-FIVE YEARS.

The New England mackerel fishery has reached its lowest point short of almost absolute extinction. The report of the Massachusetts Inspector-General of Fish for 1889 has been given to the public, by which it appears that the whole number of barrels of mackerel inspected in the Commonwealth last year was 27,067 1/2 bbls, the smallest product for any year since 1815.
