Safety In The Kitchen Starts With The Floor

It's sad news that home accidents are on the increase. And a close-up look at statistics reveals how many of them occur in the kitchen.

What the average homemaker needs to help cut down this type of accident, is a non-skid kitchen—step ladders and stools with rubber-tipped feet, foam rubber mat and other dependable types that stay put on the floor, work surfaces free of grease, a floor kept mopped clean of slick spots and spill.

This means constant vigilance, but this is easy compared to the misery incurred by an accident. A single slide in today's compact kitchen and the cook can ricochet from stove and a burned elbow to the drainboard and a pile of broken crockery plus, perhaps, a couple of badly gashed hands.

That's the true story of more than one accident taken from insurance records.

KEEPING SAFE
The easiest way to keep a kitchen floor safe and clean is to mop up any spills and splashes the moment they occur. Then a quick once-over with a suds mop, and wipe dry with a cloth. Never leave the floor wet.

Be careful about work surfaces where food is prepared. These should not only be clean at the start, but kept clean while work is in progress. Large bowls and glasses slide all too quickly on a surface that's left slippery.

And speaking of sliding glasses and china, never grab a dish towel to wipe your soapy hands. When you're ready to dry dishes later, the concentrated soap on the towel may make you drop your best glassware and cut your hands!

WASHING DISHES
When dish-washing, never put sharp knives in the bottom of dishpan or sink where they become hidden under suds and dishes. As your hands fumble around in the pan, they could grab a dangerous cutting edge.

Wash sharp knives individually where you can see what you're doing.

Glasses that contained cold drinks should be allowed to reach room temperature before being washed. Wash glassware in warm suds, then rinse in clear hot water. A very hot rinse is safe, once the glass has been gradually warmed. And never hold a glass directly under the faucet; if it's too hot or too cold, it may crack.

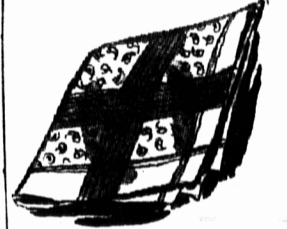
