Big Dredging Project At Savage Harbour This Year

As indicated in the Estimates, the Federal Government has made provision for the dredging of Savage Harbour and word to this effect has been received by Mr. W. Chester S. McLure, M.P., in a letter from Hon. R. W. Mayhew, Minister of Fisheries. "With further reference to your letter of March 12," Mr. Mayhew writes, "I am pleased to advise you that the Department of Public Works has made provision for the dredging of Savage Harbour, P. E. I., on the program for Departmental Dredge No. 17. "This is the largest item on the program for Dredge No. 17 which has also been allotted projects for 1952-53 at Rustico and a number of other harbours. A large part, if not all the dredging at Savage Harbour, should be completed in 1952-53." The vote placed in the estimates for the Savage Harbour project is \$156,000.
