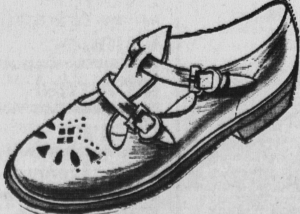

Teen-Age Gang Warfare Strikes On British Beaches

LONDON (CP)—Death on the highways and wild teen-age violence on the beaches saddened and outraged Britons on their long Whitsun weekend, one of the biggest holidays of the year. In the most widespread teen-age gang warfare yet seen here, Mods and Rockers ran amok at Margate and Brighton so badly Sunday and Monday a magistrate compared them with packs of fighting rats. Knives flashed in the Margate sun and five youths were taken to hospital with stab wounds, one of them also suffering head injuries when a starting gun was fired near his face.

Even more serious was the highway toll which reached a record for the four-day Whitsun, or pentecost, holiday. The temperature soared into the 70s and the weather was generally beautiful, luring motorists onto the highways in unprecedented numbers. The toll climbed to 47 by mid night Sunday night and higher than that before the big turnaround began by mid-afternoon Monday. Last year only 81 persons died in the four-day period but in 1960 the toll reached 94. PLEA TO DRIVERS

Ghastly was the word used by a transport department spokesman, who pleaded with motorists to try to stagger their return and to exercise care and tolerance. Car queues stretched as long as 25 miles Sunday. Police were braced for trouble after their experience with wholesale Mod-Rocker violence at Clacton-On-The-Sea, on the East Coast, at Easter. But they were hardly prepared for the spring madness that descended on Margate, 70 miles east of London, and Brighton, 50 miles south, when the dandified Mods—Moderns—arrived on their motor scooters and the leather-jacketed Rockers roared in on their motor cycles. Screaming girl friends urged the youths to battle. "Fifty-one youths were brought into court Monday morning at

Margate — and received sentences ranging up to fines of £75 (£25) and six months detention. Magistrate George Simpson declared: "These long-haired, mentally unstable, petty little scoundrel Casars only find courage like rats by hunting in packs." POLICE WERE JEERED

Mockery, abuse, filthy language and jeers were among the more minor trials the police had to endure. A television announcer giving the news from Margate, harried by grinning, gesticulating, yelling teen-agers, turned on his commentators and told his audience: "This is the sort of thing we have to cope with at Margate." Some 2,000 of the teen-agers hit Margate alone, causing parents to gather up their small children and head for home or other beach squads. Mobile police squads stood from beach to beach, breaking up battles. Ambulances took away the wounded. "Even outside the courts, marching Mods shouted to the

Rockers: "Come on out you scoundrels!" Two youths were stabbed outside one court at Margate. SANDS LITTERED

The sands and the boardwalks where the youths clashed from dawn to dusk were littered with ripped-up boards, broken beach chairs, bottles, refuse and shattered shop windows. Reporters estimated 3,000 teen-agers fought at Brighton with the Rockers apparently getting the worst of it. Authorities said more than 1,000 fought at Brighton. Police also broke up crowds of youths massed near the pier at Southend, across the Thames from Margate. And northward, at Clacton, mobile police forces headed off the motorized youth approaching town. Even the crowded railway stations were not safe. One depot restaurant was wrecked by teen-agers, who threw tableware and food at each other while 200 other persons were trying to eat. "They all ought to be put in jail!" shouted a mother. "They

are all a nasty, dirty, stinking lot!"

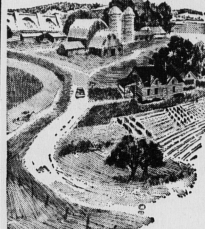
