NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market retreated again Tuesday but amid increasing signs of resistance and on the lightest trading since early June.
The Dow Jones industrial average, which had been down as much as 4.40, closed with a net loss of 3.00 at 87.25.
Late in the day, Jones and Laughlin spurred 1% to 82% following a report it will build one of the largest ironmaking blast furnaces at its Pittsburgh works.
Other steel stocks peaked up a bit, Bethlehem and U.S. Steel 1/4. After the market close, U.S. Steel declared its usual dividend and reported profits. Second-quarter earnings were below the second quarter of 1963. But this was due to hedge buying because of a steel strike last year. The six-month profit this year was ahead of 1963's.
The Associated Press said that 600000 steel workers are on strike in 11 at 3077.
Sunshine mining again topped the most-lost list, losing 1/4 at 24% on 100,000 shares as profits were taken. Borden was a second, unchanged at 3 1/2. Third-year Chrysler, up 1/4 at \$2 on 45,000 shares, up 1/4.
General Match rose 1/4, Control Data 1/4, Raytheon and General Dynamics 1/4, Goodway, Public Service Electric and Gas 1/4, Liggett and Myers 1/4.
Du Pont fell 1/4. General Motors 1/4, Ford fell 1/4. Sears, Roebuck 1/4, New York Central 1/4, and Standard Oil Indiana 1/4.
Domestic Airlines and McIntyre closed and Aluminum Ltd. 1/4. Distillers Securities was up 1/4. Dome Mines, Hudson Bay Mining and International Nickel 1/4 and Canadian Pacific 1/4.
Prices slid irregularly on the American Stock Exchange. Scurry Rainbow Oil gained 1/4 and Canadian Nickel 1/4 but others included Canadian Jubilee, Preston and Fargus Oil 1/4.
Brazilian Tracton, Combined He and Jupiter Corp. continued unchanged.

MONTREAL (CP) - A sharp decline in the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges Tuesday. The composite index was off 0.5 to 104. The industrial index sank 0.7 to 105.8. Utilities lost 0.5 on index to 140.2.
Maritime Telegraph and Telephone slipped 1/4 to 20 1/2. Calgary Power and CPR 1/4 each to 25% and 40%, and Trans-Union Pacific Line 1/4 to 19%.
Fibers dropped 1/4 to 42 1/2. Domtar 1/4 to 22%, and Price Street 1/4 to 40 1/2.
In banks, the index advanced 0.6 to 110.1, Canadian Imperial Banking to 67 1/2, Montreal and Nova Scotia 1/4 each to 74% and 74%, and Royal 1/4 to 74%.
Senior bond markets were better. International Nickel slipped 1/4 to 84% and Cominco and 27%.
Noranda edged up 1/4 to 82.
Senior oil stocks were mixed. Imperial and Home B declined 1/4 each to 51% and 18%.
Primary metals were weaker. Algonquin and Defasco eased 1/4 each to 74% and 25, and Dominion Bridge 1/4 to 22%. Canadian Foundry edged up 1/4 to 22%.
In speculative mines, McAdam dropped eight cents to 81 cents. New Imperial came within 1/4 of 40 cents, and also one cent to 29 cents.

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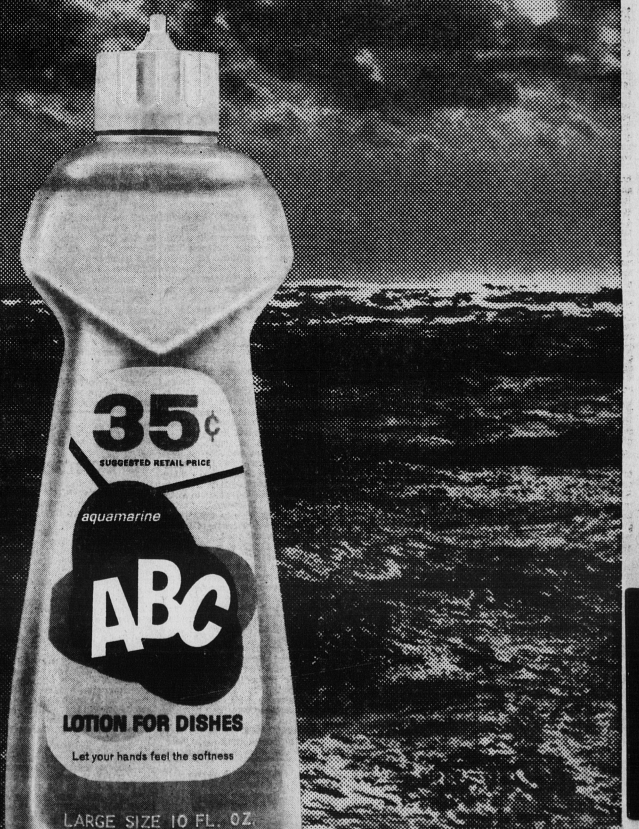
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
