

WHAT'S HAPPENING

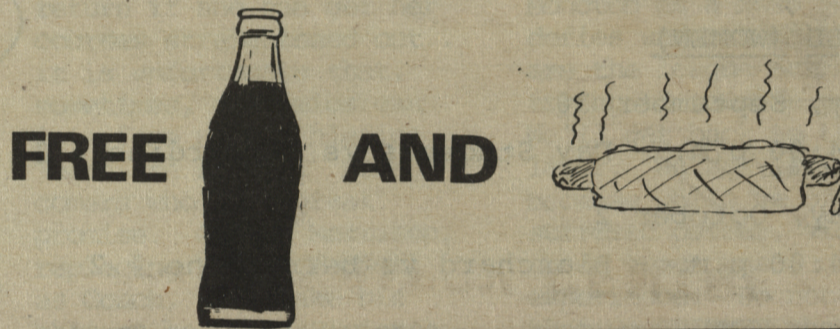
Do you think that you drink too much?
