

'Copter Survey To Fix Height Of Mt. Kennedy

OTTAWA (CP)—Mount Kennedy in the Yukon, climbed for the first time last week by a party which included Senator Robert F. Kennedy of New York, will be visited again in April by surveyors in a helicopter.

The exact position and height of the mountain named after the late president John F. Kennedy is to be fixed by a joint Canada - U.S. geodetic survey project starting April 15.

The height of the mountain had been estimated at 13,900 feet but Senator Kennedy said the climbing party's altimeter showed it was more than 14,000. It is in the southwest corner of the Yukon, near the juncture of the Yukon - British Columbia-Alaska boundaries.

The helicopter will land the surveyors at or near the summit. A brass geodetic marker will be embedded in the rock there.

The isolated region is being surveyed for the first time.


