Rivard Search Is Continued

MONTREAL (CP) — The search for Lucien Rivard dragged on through its eighth day Wednesday with police reporting nothing to indicate they are close to finding the elusive jailbreaker.

A police spokesman said that while the \$15,000 reward offered by the federal government for Rivard's recapture might be helpful as the manhunt progresses, it produced no immediate results.

Rivard, a narcotics conspiracy suspect and central figure in the Dorian inquiry, has not been seen by authorities since he and fellow prisoner Andre Durocher escaped from Bon-sieux Jail here March 2. Since then, police have raided close to 100 suspected criminal haunts in Montreal and district without finding any trace of the escapees. Rumors of Rivard being sighted everywhere from Saint John, N.B., to Vermont also have been checked with a similar lack of results.
