**Wheat Acreage Increases By Seven Per Cent**

**OTTAWA (CP) —** Prairie wheat planting is about 26,300,000 acres or seven per cent higher than last year and the largest since 1950, a preliminary estimate by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics said here.

This includes a record 17,000,000 acres estimated for Saskatchewan.

Wednesday's double-barrelled report combines the fifth in a series of nine crop reports for all Canada.

Information is based on telegraphed information despatched up to Tuesday night by field representatives.

Elsewhere, Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia have had cool weather. The island needs more warmth and moisture, though most crops have enjoyed good growth.

Potatoes and pastures are satisfactory.

Nova Scotia crops are later than usual. Haying has begun and the first strawberries have been marketed.

New Brunswick crops have had generally a rather and made satisfactory progress. Quebec generally in the last two weeks has had dry weather and cool nights. General crops appear good but growth is slow. Hay yields are poor to good, though quality is excellent. Potatoes appear to be doing well.
