WINNIPEG, July 3 - (CP) - Coarse grain futures prices moved narrowly today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Hesitation which appeared was attributed to an easing tone on U.S. grain markets. Commercial demand was less aggressive but some shippers buying appeared in oats and barley. Trading reports said a small overseas business had developed as well in sales of oats to American interests. Flax brought some support from industrial accounts and American interests took rye. Offerings were fairly liberal at times. No information on overnight loadings of Canadian wheat for export was available. Prices of class two and I. W. A. wheat were down one-half cent.
