**MONTREAL**  
 MONTREAL (CP) — Irregularly stronger tendencies showed Thursday at the closing of the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges. Trading was quiet. Most changes were fractional.  
 Banks increased slightly. Montreal made the biggest gain at 57 1/2, up 1/4.  
 International Utilities jumped 1 1/2 to 35 and Lower St. Lawrence increased 1 to 38. Other utility movements showed irregular fractions.  
 In papers, Crown Zellerbach lost 1 1/2 to 21 and International Paper was firmer at 125 1/2, up 1/2. Bowater Paper was up 1/4 at 7 1/4. Consolidated Paper was up 1/4 at 40.  
 Pipelines, base metals and steels showed minor and irregular movements.  
 Merchandising issues were firmer. Reitmans leaped 3 1/2 to 42. Simpsons increased 1 1/2 to 36 1/2 and Zellers increased 1/2 to 36 1/2.  
 Texaco gained 2 1/4 at 67.  
 Penny stocks were irregular.
