Boycott Proposals Shunned By U.S. Medical Association

NEW YORK (AP) — The American Medical Association shunned proposals Thursday to strike doctors by boycott medical care and advised, instead, that each doctor let his conscience be his guide.

Faced with likely passage, perhaps in July, of the federal program to provide health care for the U.S. aged through social security, the AMA's top policy group said.

Resources Minister Defends Federal Oil Permits Action

OTTAWA (CP) — Resources Minister Lesage said Thursday his department followed "perfectly normal procedure" in granting an oil and gas exploration permit covering 9,500,000 acres in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

"We took this action on the basis of an agreement signed by 22 nations under the Law of the Sea which gives jurisdiction over such offshore resources to the country whose land is adjacent," Mr. Lesage told a reporter.
