Consultant Conducts Reading Clinic For Kensington Area

Student Counselling Sessions Are Planned

The Charlottetown office of the National Employment Service, in cooperation with the Dept. of Education and the Charlottetown Rotary Club, is working out details of a Career Counselling Program for Grades XI and XII students in Queens and Kings counties.

The program, whereby students are counselled in their choice of 25 occupations, is to be held at Prince of Wales College, Nov. 6. Approximately 800 students from 100 Schools, as well as Grade XI and XII students from Prince of Wales College, Notre Dame Academy and St. Dunstan's are to attend, it was announced by the National Employment Office here.

Counselors are being selected by a committee of the Charlottetown Rotary Club, chaired by William Smith, author and lecture rooms are being arranged for by Gordon Bennett, registrar of Prince of Wales College; meals for out-of-town students are being provided at Montgomery Hall through the co-operation of Malcolm MacKenzie, Deputy Minister of Education; transportation for out-of-town students will be under the control of the principals of the participating schools.

Frank B. Ashmore and Clifford Orford, special services officers with the National Employment office at Charlottetown, are co-ordinating the program. Other arrangements are being planned by the National Employment Office for Career Counselling of students at Charlottetown and Montserrat Regional High Schools. These plans will be announced later.
