ON THE STAGE AT LAST.

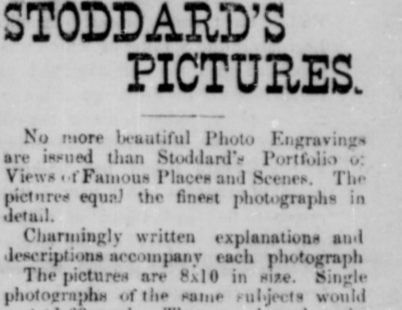

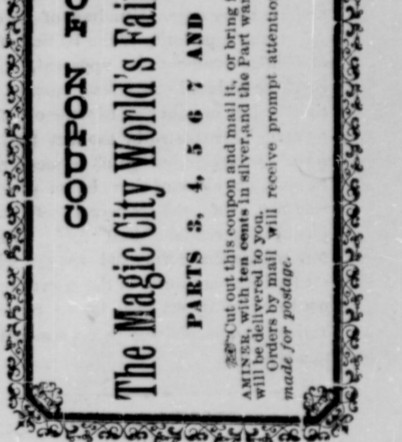
