

FEEDS, MINERALS AND CONDITIONERS

Animal nutrition has made notable strides in recent years and more and more farmers are buying greater quantities of their livestock feeds and supplements in sacks.

Purchases may be divided into three main classes. (1) Feeds, (2) Minerals and (3) preparations known as Conditioners and Tonic-Conditioners.

Feeds are regulated under the Feeding Stuffs Act, and the purchaser has reasonable assurance of the quality and content. Conditioners and tonics are not registered under this Act but are sold under the Food and Drug Act.

Minerals are a comparatively inexpensive supplement, ranging in price from \$3.50 to \$6.00 per cwt. The farmer who requires a mineral feed should not buy conditioners, as these, while they may contain minerals, cost about three times as much and are not properly balanced.

COUNTY MEETINGS

While firm dates have not yet been set for the Annual Meetings of the County Federations, the planning of the programme is going on. BULL OR STEER

A recent test conducted at an experimental farm in Western Canada was designed to establish information on the relative efficiency of bulls and steers in making gain and in turning feed into meat. The bulls and steers were weaned at six months and then fed until a weight of 900 pounds was reached. The experiment showed the bulls to gain 2.4 pounds per day while the steers put on 1.9. To produce 0 pounds of meat the bulls required 399 pounds of grain while the steers required on the average 429 days. To the farmers who are raising beef, we suggest that these figures are of importance and what they indicate worthy of very careful consideration in the handling of feeder cattle.

We are in receipt of a letter from the Royal Agricultural Society of England announcing the fact that next year's Royal Show will be held at Newcastle upon Tyne, July 3 to 6. The letter extends an invitation to our members to visit the show and offers to provide complimentary tickets. WIRE FENCING

Under the Combines Investigation Act, power is granted the Director, included in last year's work was an investigation of the wire fencing manufacturers. This group was found to have exercised under arrangement from 1933 practices to maintain prices and to eliminate competition. The evidence shows that for almost 20 years the manufacturers attended meetings and agreed upon common prices, terms and conditions of sale to all classes of customers. The erection of chain link fences on occasion required the provision by the factory of a construction foreman. If more than one job was being done at the same location, a policy which would appear to add additional costs which would hardly be justified.

SHIPPING RESTRICTIONS

Canadian coastal shipping interests have been making demands to have British shipping and British-built ships barred from the Canadian coastal trade. Included in the Brief presented to a commission investigating this matter was one from the Canadian Federation of Agriculture. This Brief strongly opposed placing any restrictions upon British ships operating in our coastal trade. The main reasons for the Federation's stand in this matter are stated as follows:

1. Mean higher freight charges than those which can be expected if the Seaway opens without new restrictions on coasting trade.
2. Deprive the British of an important source of Canadian dollars, thus hurting Canada's export trade.
