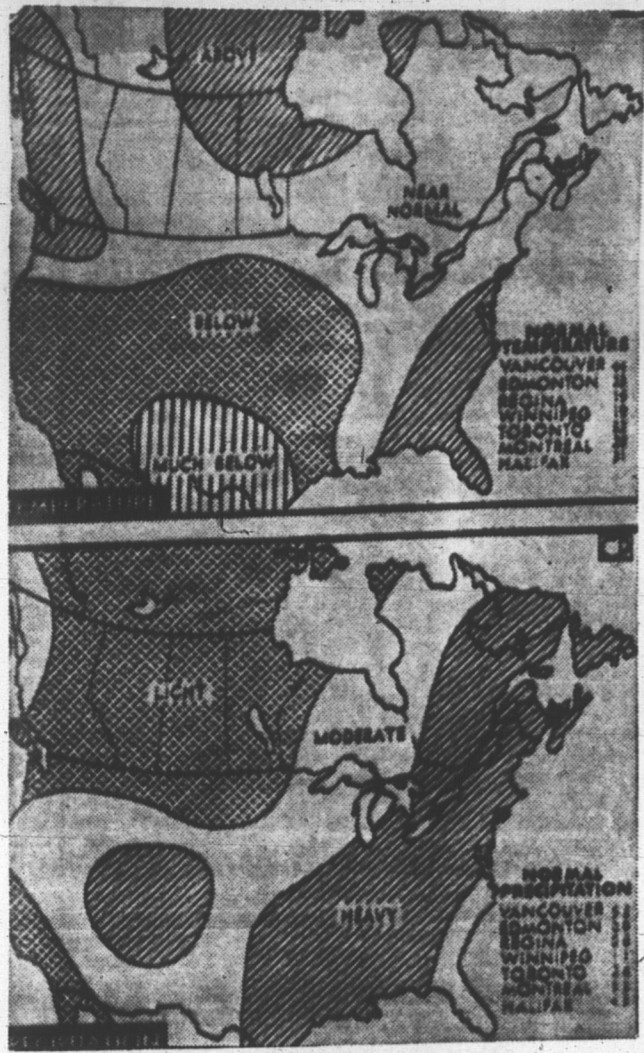

## True Spy Ring Story Is Hot-Selling Book

MOSCOW (AP)—The story of a Soviet spy ring during the Second World War, apparently based on a true case and purporting to give the lowdown on the German Nazi intelligence, is the hottest-selling novel in Moscow. A line of Russians standing four abreast for more than two blocks waited outside the small bookstore of the Union of Soviet Writers last week. The first edition of 30,000 copies was sold out in hours.

A new edition of 200,000 copies is planned for sale March 26, clearly timed for the 23rd congress of the Soviet Communist party, opening the next day.

The novel, *Shield and Sword* by Vadim Kozhevnikov, continues a campaign started about two years ago to improve the tarnished image of Soviet security organs. The campaign glorifies spies and secret police agents after years of keeping their activities secret.

For example, Col. Rudolf Abel, the Soviet spy exchanged for U-2 pilot Francis Gary Powers, is writing his memoirs. He describes FBI agents as "ambassadors in parts that have been published."

ISN'T ALL FICTION

Kozhevnikov's novel gives readers a thriller based on real people and historic events rather than the usual novel of socialist realism glorifying Communism.

## Ottawa Is Asked To Ponder Sidewalks For Trans Canada

OTTAWA (CP) — Russell Keays (PC-Gaspe) has asked the government to consider inserting clauses in Trans-Canada Highway contracts calling for the building of sidewalks or pedestrian safety zones where the road passes through rural areas.

In his notice of motion debated during the hour set aside for private members' business, Mr. Keays said such safety areas would be useful in rural areas where neighbors are close enough to visit each other on foot.

The matter still was under discussion when the hour ended. It drops to the end of the list of such items to be debated during the session.

John B. Stewart, parliamentary secretary to Works Minister McRath, said building safety areas for pedestrians would defeat the purpose of the Trans-Canada Highway. It was for high-speed traffic and the provinces should provide for

## Selassie Sees Threat In Coups

ADDIS ABABA (AP) — Emperor Haile Selassie of Ethiopia said here in his state of coups continues in Africa, "irreparable damage" will be done to the continent.

He said it is imperative to ensure peace and stability in African countries "to prevent the rise of events that could detract our attention from the problem of Rhodesia."

The Ethiopian monarch was addressing a foreign ministers' meeting of the Organization of African Unity.

He told the delegates the white-minority regime in Rhodesia never will be toppled unless the 37 member countries of the OAU act unanimously.

Thana, whose president was ousted last week in a military coup, was represented by delegates of the new regime.
