Monthly Pension Benefits Are Listed In This Table

OTTAWA (CP)—The following table shows monthly benefits payable to the widow and dependent children of a man who dies at any age while contributing to the federal pension plan. The benefits are listed according to the husband's annual income at the time of his death. Maximum income allowed in calculating benefits is \$3,000 a year.

Income: \$2,400 \$3,000 \$3,000
Widow with: One child 68.75 78.12 80.00
Two 83.75 103.12 114.00
Three 108.75 128.12 140.00
Four 133.75 153.12 166.00
Widow only 43.75 53.12 64.00

Allowances are paid for dependent children to age 18, for children still in school aged 18 to 25, and for disabled children. A childless widow receives full benefits herself only if she is 45 or older when her husband dies.

Beaverbrook Title Dropped By His Son

LONDON (CP)—Lord Beaverbrook's son has renounced the title he succeeded to on the death of his father and said there will be only one Lord Beaverbrook.

Max Aitken, 34, ordinarily would have become second Baron Beaverbrook on the death Tuesday of the Canadian-born newspaper publisher and philanthropist.

"The title was earned and won by my father," Aitken said. "I brought on it a unique distinction which belongs to him alone."

Aitken has inherited his father's vast business and publishing enterprises.

Meanwhile, arrangements for the cremation of Lord Beaverbrook's body were still secret.

Aitken said a private service would be held from Cherkley, Lord Beaverbrook's country home, followed by cremation "shortly."

A memorial service would be held later, he added. The Lord Chancellor's office announced it had received Aitken's instrument of disclaimer.

The title, which Lord Beaverbrook took from the name of a small stream near his boyhood home at Newstead, N.S., will be dormant during Aitken's lifetime.

But Aitken's son—he has one, and a daughter, by his third wife—can decide for himself what he wants to do about the title. He can accept it or not, as he chooses, upon his father's death.

Fifth Grade Failure Heads For College

TITUSVILLE, Fla. (AP)—Bill Green, aged 12 and a fifth grade failure, went to a private college. Educationists say the fact that Billy makes the grade without a private tutor is a mental capability of a college freshman.

Monday Billy begins a six-week freshman course called "physical science survey" at the University of Florida.

Senate Okays River Treaty

The Senate's approval, following earlier passage in the Commons, paves the way for an exchange by Canada and the U.S. of instruments of ratification.

The U.S. Congress approved the treaty in 1961.
