Former Islander Dies At Shediac

His many friends in the Maritimes will learn with regret of the death of Oscar K. Myers, Shediac Cape, which occurred at his home. A native of Prince Edward Island, Mr. Myers was the son of Robert and Lilla Myers, Hampton. For over 26 years he served as a double-service telegrapher for the Canadian Marconi Company. He visited many other lands while employed by the company and long hauls to the Antipodes were commonplace for him. His log book shows he sailed on all oceans except the Antarctic and Indian. His last appointment afloat was on the RMS Lady Hawkins on the Canada-West Indies run. During the Second Great War he was transferred to VAS Marconi Towers, Glace Bay, N.S. He retired in 1946 and made his home at Shediac Cape. Mr. Myers is survived by his wife, the former Sarah Myatt, Oxford, N. S., also two sisters, Mrs. Alma McMicken and Mrs. J. D. Whetham, both of Calgary, Alta. The funeral service was conducted by Rev. Mr. Jones, United Church, Shediac, with the church choir assisting. Pall bearers were Vernon Moore, Willie Myers, John L. Sturdy, Eric Lowther, Frank Myatt and Arthur Myatt. Interment was in Pine Grove cemetery, Oxford, N. S. where the service at the graveside was conducted by Zeland Lodge No. 24 Shediac. The profusion of floral tributes and messages of sympathy received testified to the high esteem in which Mr. Myers was held.

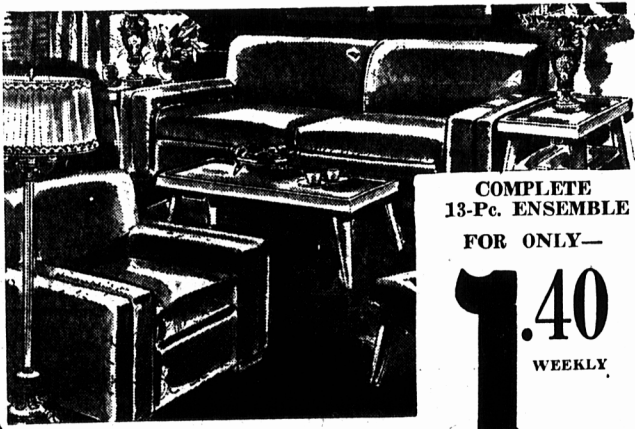

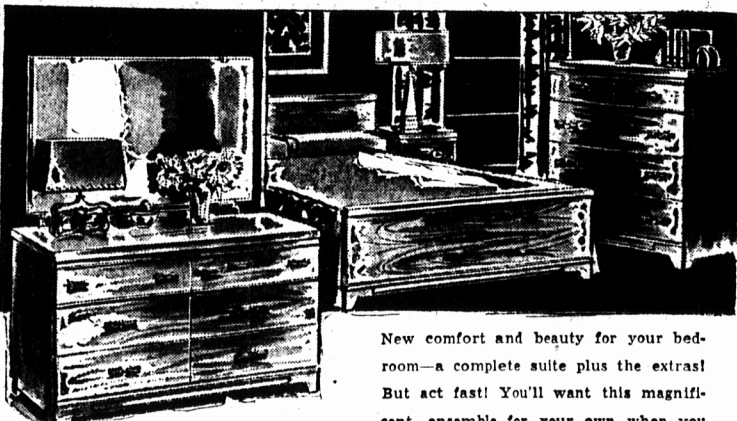

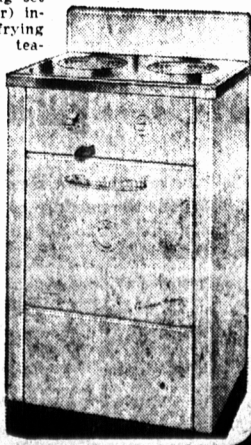
