Bobby Hull Paces Hawks To 7-4 Win Over Leafs

CHICAGO (AP)—Bobby Hull's second three-goal night of the National Hockey League season paced Chicago Black Hawks to a 7-4 victory over Toronto Maple Leafs Sunday night.

The victory moved the Black Hawks to within two points of the fourth-place Boston Bruins, beaten 4-2 by Detroit.

All of Chicago's goals were scored in the second period. Ken Wharram opened the attack with the first of his two goals at 4:35 of the middle frame.

NEW YORK (CP)—New York Rangers exploded for four goals in the third period Sunday night to defeat Montreal Canadiens 6-5.

Schinkel started Montreal's downfall, scoring at 1:24 of the third on passes from John Hanna and Cullen.
