MONTREAL (CP) — The U.S. dollar closed Wednesday at a discount of 2 1-32 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, down 1-32. Pound sterling \$2.75 down 5-16.			
TORONTO			
TORONTO (CP) — The stock market failed to hold a slight rise Wednesday and sunk narrowly lower amid the slowest trading in more than five weeks.			
Western oils led the mild decline with an index-loss of 1 1/4 points. Golds and base metals had small losses.			
The market opened with no definite trend, swung narrowly to the upside before noon and held that level until an hour before the close. Brokers said the decline was a result of a lack of buying rather than any sustained selling.			
Senior western oils lost fractional ground and the lower-priced index stocks joined in on a moderate scale. The losses in the section outnumbered gains nearly three-to-one.			
Senior base metals, uranium and golds were narrowly lower. Medium-priced mines generally lost ground but the individual declines were small.			
Index losses: golds 21 to 79.21; base metals .13 to 147.43; western oils 1.24 to 128.51.

From One Cook to Another

ECONOMY MEATS GO GLAMOROUS

• Meats contribute so much to meals, in enjoyment and nourishment. Yet meat can be our biggest meal-planning problem, because of expense! Well—I have a number of ideas to give interest to economy meats. One has to do with ground beef. To give it new goodness, nothing quite equals Carnation Evaporated Milk. NEW WAY TO COOK GROUND BEEF

1/4 cup (small can) undiluted CARNATION EVAPORATED MILK

1 1/2 lbs. ground beef

1/2 cup fine cracker crumbs

1 1/2 tsp. pepper

Combine all ingredients, mixing well.

CREOLE MEAT LOAF: Turn the Carnation-beef mixture into greased loaf pan, 8 x 4 x 2 inches. Bake in moderate oven (350° F.) about 1 hour. Let loaf stand in pan 10 minutes. Heat 1 can condensed tomato soup with 2 tablespoons ketchup, dash of horseradish. Turn loaf out on platter; cover with the hot tomato sauce. Makes 6 servings.

BANQUET-BURGERS: Shape meat mixture as six large flat patties. Broil patties 10 minutes on one side. Turn "Burgers" and top each with a slice of tomato and slice of onion. Broil 10 minutes longer. Serve at once between toasted split hamburger buns. Makes 6 servings.

CARNATION KEBABS: Make 24 small hamburger balls from meat mixture. Put half small tomato, hamburger ball, thin onion slice, another hamburger ball and second tomato half on each of 12 skewers. Brush lightly with melted fat. Broil on each side 5 minutes. Makes 12 kebabs.
