WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands Prorogued until Thursday, the Seventeenth day of August, inst:

I have thought fit, by and with the advice of Her Majesty's Executive Council, further to prorogue the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued until Thursday the Twenty-first September next, of which all persons concerned are required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of this Island, at Charlottetown, in the said Island, this 14th day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, and in the Twenty-eighth year of Her Majesty's reign.
