Rabbit Killing Plant Is Planned For Calgary

CALGARY (CP)—Meat packers boast they can use every part of pig but the squeal. That doesn't impress Richard Rochu of Calgary who says "every part of the rabbit can be used for something or other."

Mr. Rochu is president of the Alberta Rabbit Breeders Association, which plans to open a \$50,000 rabbit abattoir here this summer.

He says market surveys indicate the major problem will be finding enough rabbits to meet the demand—estimated at 500 a day in early stages of operation.

"There is a good market in Calgary and a good one in Edmonton. This will be the first rabbit abattoir in Western Canada."

CHRYSLER HDS New Turbine

DETROIT (AP)—The future of Chrysler Corporation's turbine car program rested today on experiments being conducted with a new breed of turbine engine.

Chrysler officials confirmed that a new engine, the fifth generation in its turbine program, had been developed. Road tests are scheduled to begin shortly.

Chrysler said earlier this month that it would make a decision by late spring or early summer on the future of the turbine engine program.

Lynn A. Townsend, Chrysler president, told the firm's annual shareholders meeting Tuesday that results of more than 1,000,000 miles of test driving were still being evaluated.

Chrysler spokesmen gave no hint as to whether they felt the new engine might provide the momentum Chrysler needs to get the turbine-powered car on the market.

The turbine engine, which has only one-eighth the parts of a conventional piston engine, runs on any number of fuels with white kerosene as the most widely-used propellant.
