SUNSHINE FOR COWS.

Gloomy Surroundings a Cause of Tuberculosis.

Cows like plants, need not only light but sunshine, says George E. Newell in the Boston Cultivator. In winter they are necessarily deprived of more of it than in summer. Now the pale sunlight, while it possesses but little warmth is by each lengthening day increased in efficacy and should not be withheld from milk cows.

No plan is more insanitary than to keep cows confined in a gloomily sunless stable, while out side the premises are flooded in the genial warmth of Sol's rays.

All cow stables should be so constructed as to catch every bit of winter sunshine possible, the more the better. To this end they should be well lighted if possible with south windows and these windows be kept free of those curtains of filth—cobwebs and dust.

Cows kept in sunless stables are affected about the same way that plants are in sunless rooms. They are sickly and have diminished vitality.

It is in such stables that tuberculosis lurks, and all the legislation in the world will not obviate this disease until dairymen better learn and practice the principles of hygiene. Keep cows out of the gloom and in the sunshine if you would have healthy vigorous animals capable of yielding a maximum quantity of milk.

It is for this reason that I earnestly advocate tightly inclosed barnyards, acting as wind breaks where cows may sun themselves for short periods on warm winter days.

The ordinary barnyard is a refrigerator in winter and a cesspool in summer, and for cows to go into it out of the stable is like stepping from the frying pan into the fire.

Barnyards should be the warmest, coziest most sheltered nook about the dairy premises. In other words they should be a blessing and not a curse.

If properly protected by wind break walls, and in ordinary weather cows can be turned out of it to their great advantage in the middle of nearly every winter's day.

The ordinary plan of turning them out every forenoon in a yard perhaps swept by cold blasts, or permitting them to wander at will to the frozen stream is what saps their vitality and helps to render them "spring poor."

Colored Spots in Cheese.

Under the direction of the dairy commissioner of Canada a careful study and report of an outbreak of colored spots in a Canadian factory were made by Dr. W. T. Connell. The factory was found to be well located, but not well kept. As is too frequently the case with cheese factories the utensils and vats in daily use were fairly well cleaned, but in general the factory had an untidy appearance. In particular the drains were very defective and filthy. The drainage from the factory was intended to enter a drain under the floor, but a close connection between the floor and drain was not made, and it had to fall 18 inches to the trough. A considerable part of it splashed over on to the ground underneath, which was kept constantly saturated, and in a slimy condition. The color of the slimy mass varied from reddish to reddish yellow or reddish gray. Bacteriological examination of this substance revealed many forms of low organic life, and bacilli were discovered which closely resembled a form found in the affected cheese. The salt, rennet and samples of milk delivered by the different patrons were also examined, but without finding suspicious germs in any of them. There seemed little doubt but that the defective drain and its surroundings were the source of infection, and to prove that the chromogenic germ abundant about the drain, could cause the trouble. culture of the bacilli introduced into it and was made into cheese. Within a few days the spots appeared.

Practical experience has taught the growers of early potatoes to have the greater part of the nitrogen in their potato fertilizers in the form of nitrate of soda, depending upon its quick action to hasten the development of the crop.

With any farmer or dairyman who depends upon breeding and rearing calves for the maintenance of his herd and its improvement the choice of a bull is of prime importance. That "the bull is half the herd" should not be forgotten.
