WINNIPEG, Nov. 13 (CP) - All grains except barley moved to higher levels in dull trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. More liberal hedging sales contributed to the lower trend in barley. Shippers were buying both oats and barley, while indications were that some export interest also came out in barley. Flax uncovered further industrial and local buying. Local demand also appeared in the deferred months of rye. Export loadings of Canadian wheat totalled about 2,900,000 bushels in the last two days, with the United Kingdom taking 900,000 bushels; Belgium 110,000; Germany 700,000; the republic of Ireland 315,000; Italy 200,000; Norway 230,000; Chile 370,000; and Switzerland 20,000. Outside reports also said 1,000,000 bushels of Canadian wheat had been sold to the United Kingdom. Prices for class two wheat were up two cents from yesterday. I.W.A. prices were unchanged.
