

Kart Races Draw Well

A crowd estimated to be the largest to ever see Go-Kart races at the Covehead Park was on hand at the Charlottetown district track Saturday night for the Maritime Continental competition.

Ray Birt, Charlottetown, won the stock "A" class with 47 points, while Randy Fredericks, Halifax, was second with 40 points.

Keith MacLean walked away with honors in the super "A" class as he counted 58 points, Elmer Cooper, Halifax, had 35 points.

MacLean also won a 50-lap Insurance race.

A sidelight of the program was a demonstration by the YMCA Majorettes and W.E. Scantlebury.

Speedy Scot Hints Jackpot

WESTBURY, N.Y. (AP)—Speedy Scot, winning as he received the biggest payoff in harness racing history, \$95,690.86, Saturday night when he turned the Realization Trot into a one-horse exhibition at Roosevelt Raceway.

The son of Speedster from the Castleton Farms of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Van Lennep of Lexington, Ky., was only one length in front of Express Rodney at the end of the 1:16 mile but it could have been more had driver Ralph Baldwin so desired.

The time of 2:09 3/5 missed the world record by four-fifths of a second. Donner Hanover was third in the field of eight four-year-olds, three lengths back of Express Rodney.

Speedy Scot's record paycheque included \$45,690.86 for winning the race and \$50,000 for wrapping up the Founder's Plate.

To capture the plate and its \$50,000 bonus, Speedy Scot had to put together victories in Roosevelt's Westbury Futurity as a two-year-old, the Dexter Cup as a three-year-old and the Realization as a four-year-old.

As the short priced choice of the crowd of 40,146, Speedy Scot paid \$2.40, \$2.30 and \$2.60.

Billy Rice captured the free-for-all in double dash fashion. Anthony L. and Chief's Gal combined for a juicy \$100.00 exactor and driver Harry Poulton was suspended for five racing days on the Prince Edward Island circuit.

These events occurred at Saturday night's harness racing program at Charlottetown Driving Park and over 1,000 folks were on hand for the proceedings.

The Meadow Rice horse, owned by Doug Hill, Charlottetown, had no trouble whatever making it a 1-1 summary in the feature. His miles of 1:03.5 and 2:10 gave him victories with the greatest of ease.

Anthony L. saw Sunny King romp home a winner in the Wynn's first dash before he decided to lead the parade himself. The second trip of his event found Claude Murray get his veteran horse into an early lead and hang on for an upset victory. Chief's Gal, a dismal last in the initial mile, came home second in the fifth a 2-1 combined with Anthony L. for a juicy \$47.80.

Echo Ridge Eddy and Boomtown divided honors in the 1:03.5 meetings, dashes two and six, and Dunlop B. and Garth's Best tied likewise in races three and seven.

After Jolly Dick had placed second in Echo Ridge Eddy in the night's second dash, the judges asked Harry Poulton to report to them after the night's program. There was apparent dissatisfaction with Poulton's drive and the hearing later led to a 1-1 Word from the gathering that Poulton was suspended for the next five race days.

The daily doubles were worth \$37.70 and \$30.80 and the quintilla paid lucky ticket holders \$34.90.
