Flax uncovered some exporter and processor buying. Inter-market spreading came into vogue. Export loadings of Canadian wheat included: United Kingdom 95,000 bushels; Republic of Ireland 300,000; Belgium 75,000; India 370,000; Japan 365,000; Malaya 335,000; and Germany 55,000.
