### Is Certain Stalin Was Spy For Czar

**NEW YORK (CP)**— Alexander Orlov, a former high official in the Soviet secret police (NKVD), said Wednesday that Joseph Stalin once was a spy for the czar.

"I am certain that secret files showing that Stalin was an 'agent provocateur' for the czar have come into the hands of Khrushchev," Orlov told a press conference.

"The decision to expose Stalin as an 'agent provocateur' probably is being weighed now. I am confident Khrushchev will confirm my charges."

The press conference was held in conjunction with the publication in Life magazine of an article by Orlov which he claims gives the details of "the most hideous crime conceivable to the Soviet mind," that of having been a hiring of the czar and his secret police officer in the Ukraine.
