

Delegation Investigating Possibility

OTTAWA (CP)—A nine-man delegation from West Germany will spend the next two days here investigating the possibility of uranium purchases from Canada.

But no immediate sales are likely. W. M. Gilchrist, president of the Crown-owned Eldorado Mining and Refining Ltd. said in an interview.

While in Canada, the Germans will meet Trade Minister Winters, officials of uranium firms and others connected with the mining industry.

"The visit is nothing new," Mr. Gilchrist said. There have been similar visits in the past and they will probably become more frequent in line with new developments in the nuclear power industry.

Persons in the nuclear industry have been predicting an increase in uranium demand, for several years, he said, although the present pace is "maybe six months ahead of schedule."

The German team will discuss all phases of the uranium industry, including ore reserves, export regulations and requirements, type of materials available and the possibility of foreign-owned firms entering the uranium exploration field.

The United States and European countries will need uranium for future power sources, Mr. Gilchrist added, and will want all available information on supplies to work out long-term contracts.

While immediate needs are not great, he said, new nuclear reactors now being planned in Canada take about four or five years to build, but fuel supplies must be arranged two years before completion to allow time for mining and refining.

Network Plans Are Announced

NEW YORK (AP)—Plans for a new nationwide U.S. television network were announced Monday by millionaire industrialist Daniel H. Overmyer.

Overmyer told a press conference the network, to be called the Overmyer Network, or "ON," will begin broadcasting with about 100 stations Sept. 11, 1967.

It would be the first major TV network since the American Broadcasting Company in 1948. One of ABC's former TV network presidents, Oliver Treyz, will be president of ON, Overmyer said.

Overmyer said he expects to provide the estimated \$6,000,000 to \$10,000,000 needed to launch the network—and that he has a verbal commitment from 35 stations.

The industrialist heads the D. H. Overmyer Communications Co. and also operates a large warehouse system. He told reporters he thinks independent TV stations need "programming of network calibre" to make them competitive with other television networks.

The Overmyer Network plans eight hours of programming a day, including two hours of news and a two-hour entertainment show broadcast from Las Vegas, Nev., plus live and taped entertainment, sports and public shows.

Headquarters for the new operation will be in New York City.

Union Official Found Floating

CORNER BROOK, Nfld. (CP)—The body of Camille Gagnon, president of the Schefferville Que. local of the United Steelworkers of America (U.S.W.A.), was found Tuesday floating in Ashray Lake, about 100 miles north of Labrador City, Labrador.

Gagnon left Schefferville Saturday on a fishing trip with three other men. A search was started when they failed to return.

Still missing are Yvon Pelletier, representing the central council of the steelworkers union in the Schefferville area, Sylvio Martin and Yvon Bellem, both union members.

The four had been due back Monday night to resume negotiations Tuesday with the Iron Ore Co. of Canada. A strike has tied up the company's plants at Schefferville and Labrador City and shipping and processing facilities at Sept. 12, Que.

An 18-foot aluminum boat believed used by the men was found on the shore of the lake Tuesday.

RCMP here, responsible for the Labrador section of the province, said the search for the missing men is continuing.

VILLAGES INUNDATED

CALCUTTA (AP)—More than 150 villages in India's North Bihar state are under water after three days in the region burst their banks, reports reaching here said. At least 200,000 persons have been affected and the flood waters are still rising, threatening other areas, the reports said. Drinking water now is scarce in the flood-hit areas.

NURSES RESUME WORK

NEW YORK (AP)—The city's licensed practical nurses returned to work Monday after hundreds of them had staged a one-day work stoppage that crippled several hospitals. The city hospitals commissioner estimated 50 to 60 per cent of the 2,000 practical nurses stayed away from work Monday to demand higher wages.

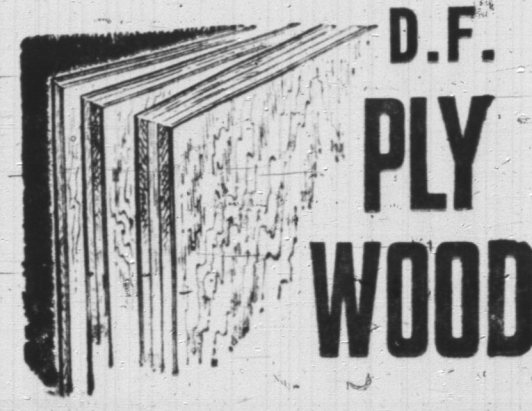
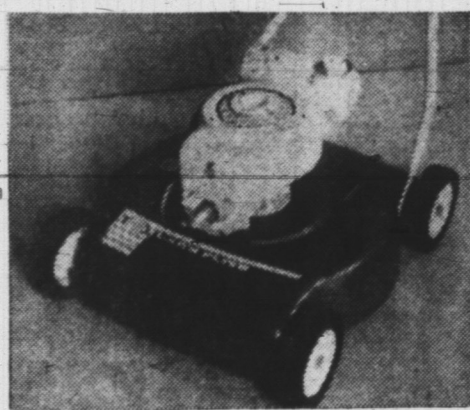

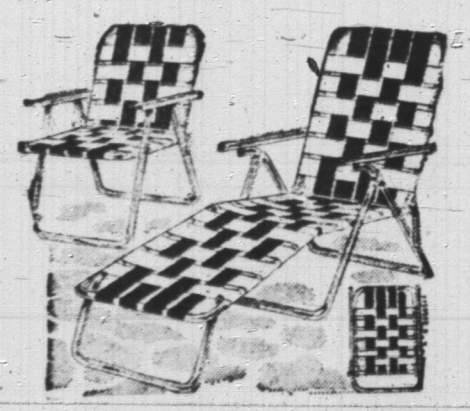
