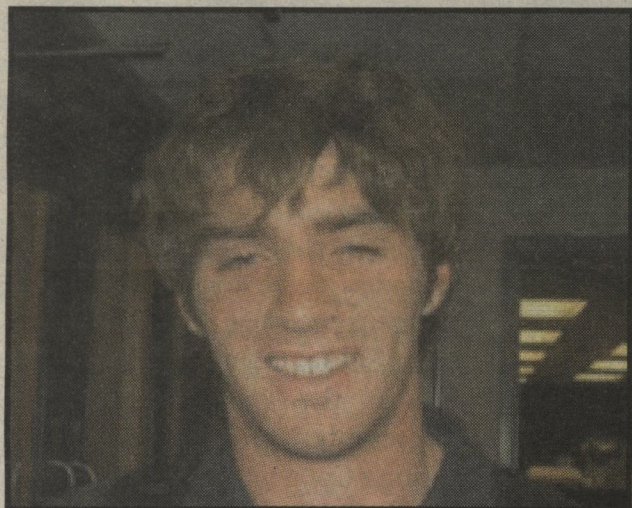


This week The Cadre asked: Is underage drinking a problem on campus?

When is drinking ever a problem?



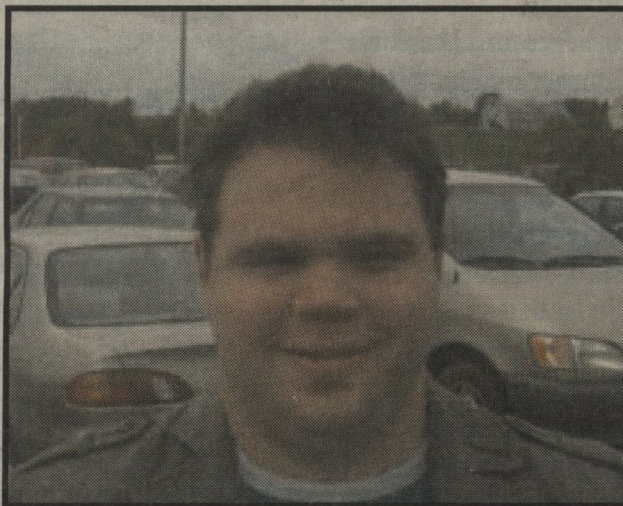
Laura Deighan - 5th Year Nutrition
