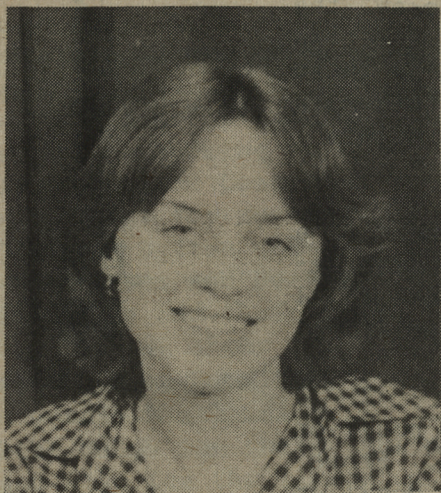

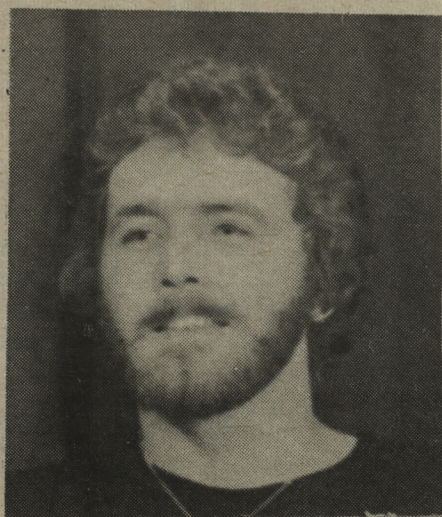


You can't remember winning the Chugging Contest.
