I have kept a sharp eye on the effect pheasants are having on our Huns and Ruffed grouse and my findings lead me to believe that their presence is having an adverse effect on our Huns and grouse.

Reliable information gathered during the past few years indicates that a lot of hen pheasants are shot each hunting season either by accident or design and the hunter who plays the game fairly sort of cheated.

Twice last fall I came across places in a thicket where a hen pheasant had been plucked. Just why the hunter figured removing the feathers would destroy its identity is beyond me.
