The competition is open to all full and part-time students at UPEI (regardless of discipline).

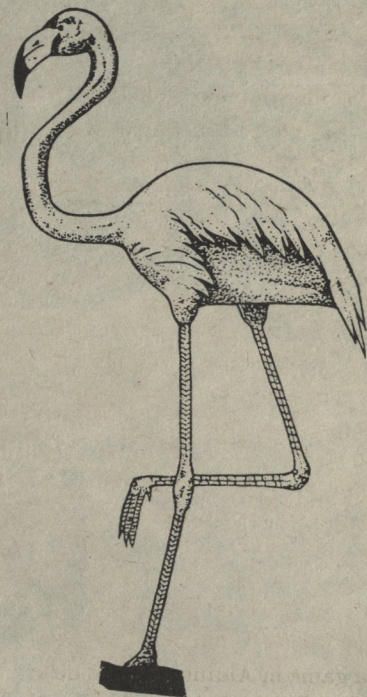
Background experience is not necessary, however, acceptable standing in your chosen field of study, dedication and good physical condition in general are a must. Some ability to draw would also be useful.
