WINNIPEG, Dec. 17 (CP) Prices displayed an easier tone today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, influenced in part by declines in U.S. markets and lack of aggressive commercial demand. A few routine shipper orders appeared in oats and barley. Industrial and export interests supported flax, while rye was taken by Americans. However, selling outweighed the demand, although prices firmed up from their lows near the close. Export loadings of Canadian wheat totalled about 1,930,000 bushels including: United Kingdom 700,000; India 350,000; Japan 320,000; Germany 360,000; Netherlands 180,000; and Costa Rica 20,000. Prices for class two wheat top grades dropped 1/2 cent from yesterday; IWA prices were up 1/2 cent. Closing prices: Oats: Dec. 81 1/2; May 81 1/2; Jly 1.16B. Canadian Dollar

MONTREAL, Dec. 17 (CP) The American dollar today closed at a discount of 2 1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, unchanged from Tuesday's closing levels. This is the lowest 97 1/2 cent Canadian to buy \$1 American. The pound sterling was \$2.72 7/16, off 1/4 from Tuesday. Ceylon was granted full Dominion status by royal assent in 1947, effective Feb. 4, 1948.

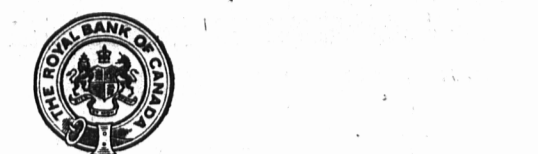
