WINNIPEG, Oct. 8 - (CP) - Purchases of barley by export houses believed connected with orders for spring shipment to the continent featured a moderately active session of the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today. Demand was fairly aggressive in deferred contract months of barley. The trade was believed connected with the sale of 500,000 to the continent. Some shipping demand appeared in oats and barley. Hesitation in late trading on U.S. markets was reflected in a reduction of some early price gains. Industrial houses and seaboard interests took some flax. There were no reports on overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat. Prices of class two wheat were down 3/4 cent; I.W.A. prices were up 1/4 cent.
