OTTAWA, The Federal Department of Public Works has awarded a contract in the amount of \$34,575.00 to Curran and Briggs Limited, of Summerside, P.E.I., for improvements to the Railway Wharf at Summerside, P.E.I. Specified completion date for the project is October, 1958. This work involves the hard surfacing of the wharf and approach by the laying of a three-inch cover of hot, plant-mixed asphalt concrete. Overall area requiring surfacing is 19,000 square yards.

### DOG MUTILATES CHILD

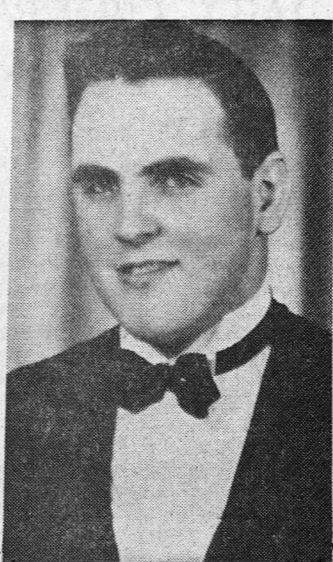

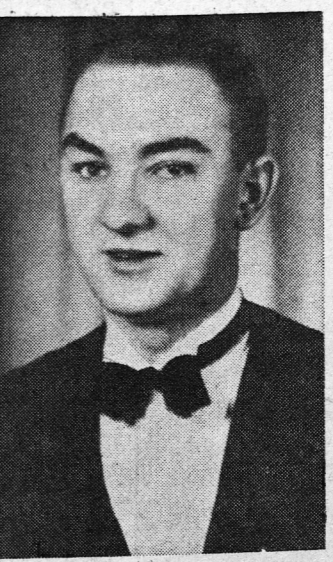
